Steve was born to Carolyn and Walter England in Yellowknife at the Con Hospital. He was delivered by Dr. Stanton and passed away at the Stanton Territorial Hospital in Yellowknife.

Steve spent his younger years in Yellowknife attending Yellowknife public school and graduated from Sir John Franklin School. He went on to take his commercial pilots license becoming a bush pilot with Koenen Air Service, Northward Aviation and Wardair. He was promoted to Wardair's international airline division flying 707, 747, DC10 in the early 70's and stayed with Wardair until the early 90's when the airline ceased operations. He flew all over the world - North America, Europe, Asia with Mandarin Air, Japan Airlines and Korean Air and ferrying Aircraft to international destinations. He loved flying- it was in his blood. His father was a private pilot and son Greg flew with Cathay Pacific in Hong Kong. In his last few years, he drove the Pepsi truck for Territorial Beverages from Edmonton to Yellowknife.

He was predeceased by his wife Terry Ann, two sons Greg and Brad and his parents Walter and Carolyn.

He is survived by his brother Frank (Darlene), two sisters Diane England (Terry Boyle) and Patricia Winter (Robert) and nieces and nephews all of Yellowknife.
