Hannah Cate Dormody, born on April 15, 2002 in Yellowknife, NWT; passed away suddenly on February 12, 2022 in Calgary at 19 years of age.

Heartbroken are her dad, Garry, mother, Nola, and sisters Cara and Caelan. Also leaving to mourn are her grandparents, Hannah (Gerry) and Harry, aunts and uncles, Judy and Mike Gardner of Grand Falls-Windsor, Newfoundland, and John and Linda Moulton of Ontario and cousins Brandon and Stephanie Gardner of Newfoundland and Liam Moulton in Ontario. Hannah also had a very wide circle of friends, teammates, and former schoolmates in Yellowknife.

A private family viewing was held on February 24 with a further ceremony (family only) to be held in the summer in keeping with Hannah's aboriginal heritage. Hannah's ashes will be scattered in locations which she loved to visit and she held dear to her heart in the NWT, Newfoundland, and Ontario.

For those of you who knew Hannah you will remember her as a girl who loved to laugh and have fun. She also loved to be surrounded by people and always wanted to participate in anything where there was a crowd. While in school, Hannah played every sport she could. It didn't matter to her if she was good or bad at it; she just wanted to play and be with people.

As a child and teen, Hannah was always noted for her generosity and giving spirit. In Hannah's memory, the family asks that if you see someone struggling with mental health or addiction issues that you simply make an effort to connect with them on any level, even just a friendly greeting, and that you make a gesture, such as giving them a coffee or a meal, and please tell them it's from Hannah. She would have liked that.
