Herb moved to Yellowknife to work at the Con mine in 1972 and worked there until 1988 when he launched his own company: Safety and Risk Management. Herb trained a lot of northerners for jobs in mining, oil and gas over the past several years, working with NWT Community Mobilization, and on contract with other agencies.

One of the founding members of the St. John Ambulance Council of the NWT in 1972, Herb stayed active in the organization over the years at both the Territorial and National level. In 1996 he was made a Serving Knight of The Most Venerable Order of The Hospital of St. John of Jerusalem.

Herb was predeceased by his wife Dolly in 2002. Following his wishes, his remains were cremated and ashes will be spread at one of his favourite places.
