January 1, 1928 - March 8, 2006

Nick Lukianchuk of Brandon, passed away at the Brandon Regional Health Centre on Wednesday, March 8, 2006.

Nick was born on January 1, 1928 in Horod, Manitoba, the son of Anolie and Telka Lukianchuk. He was raised on a farm near Horod, where he also received his education. After leaving school, he set out to work in the mining industry in Northern Manitoba and Ontario. He then went on to painting elevators in Alberta, then made his way to Yellowknife, where he met his future wife, Mary Lachowski. They were married in 1962. After they were married, Nick started his own trucking company. He left the trucking industry and went on to build warehouses and

leased them to the government for several years. Nick decided to retire and sold his business to his step-son, Leo, before moving to Brandon with Mary in 1975. Nick was a member of the Sokol Hall and the Legion. He enjoyed curling, cribbage, hunting, fishing and traveling.
