After settling in London, England, he began a career in marketing software and moved to the south of England two years ago to continue developing his business.

After great success he was only recently preparing to retire to the country-side of Wales to fish and sell rare books and novels in his book store. Michael had a lasting love for all his family and friends, which began in Yellowknife and ended in England with the love of all who knew him. He was taken from us far too soon. He is very much loved and sadly missed by us all.

Michael is survived by Mom (Peggy), Dad (Peter), brothers David (Sandy) and Steve and his partner. A private memorial service was held on June 29 in Bournemouth, England.
