Lena is survived by Dan Marion, her devoted life partner of 45 years; sons Chris (Sherri), Robert; daughters Giselle, Deanna (Lance), and Joy-Ann (Georgie); grandchildren Terance, Tyler, Jocelyn, Terrell, Jantanna, Roman; Romeo (Theresa) and the love of her life Lennox; great grandchildren Tyshawn, Tanner, Kaegan, Jaxon.
