John passed away at Fairhaven Long Term Care on September 5, 2019, with his wife Adriana (Liza) by his side after a courageous and lengthy battle with Parkinson's Disease. He will be sadly missed by her and his three children, Lisa, Renee, Edward (Marla) and his two grandchildren, Raechal and Dexter as well as his four siblings, in-laws, extended family, many friends and all that knew him.

He loved the outdoors and was an avid competitor in the Arctic Winter Games, winning many medals and he was also a fierce marathon runner. After graduation from Ryerson University he headed West and then North and became instrumental in surveying the Dempster Highway from the Yukon to Inuvik, NWT as well as the highway from Inuvik to Tuktoyuktuk, which was completed in 2017. Later in his career he was a Resource Person for the Yukon Territorial Government and was involved in the settlement for Land Claims. He and Liza returned to Ontario in 2002 and settled on Buckhorn Lake for 11 years with a subsequent move to Peterborough in 2013.

In keeping with John's wishes cremation has taken place. A visitation and service have taken place at Ashburnham Funeral Home, 840 Armour Road, Peterborough last Tuesday, September 10, 2019 and a reception followed.
