January 3, 1943 - December 18, 2005

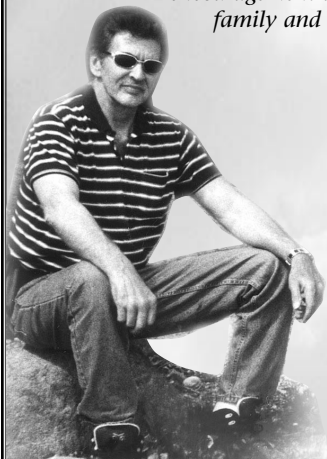
*Joseph Gerald Henry Roch passed away on
